CIVIL AVIATION CIRCULAR (CAC-MED) 01/2021

**Subject: FITNESS FOR FLYING AFTER VACCINATION AGAINST COVID-19**

**Reference: EASA Safety Information Bulletin (SIB No. 2021-06, Issued 25 Mar 2021)**

1. Due to their increased exposure, it is recommended for aircrew members to receive the COVID-19 vaccine.
2. To ensure flight safety, the air crews must not fly within 48 hours after each dose of vaccination against COVID-19. This interval must be extended to 72 hours for aircrew members performing single crew operations.
3. If any undesirable side effects after vaccination against COVID-19 appear, the aircrew must not fly and he/she is advised to consult Medical Assessor of Civil Aviation Authority of Bangladesh at the earliest.
